

Directions & Parking for Texas Memorial Museum

From I-35

1. Exit at Manor Rd., 235B.
2. Turn into campus at the traffic signal, onto Manor Rd. The name of the street will change to Clyde Littlefield Dr. as you enter campus.
3. Turn right onto Robert Dedman Dr. at the T-intersection with the football stadium.
4. Turn left onto 23rd St.
5. Turn right onto San Jacinto Blvd.

Buses must drop off all passengers near the first stop sign, the intersection of San Jacinto and 24th St, and then continue bus parking across I-35 (see below). **Buses may no longer drop off passengers on Trinity St.** **Cars and vans** may continue to the parking garage (see below). Take the second entrance onto the ramp (up to second level). Do NOT park on the ground level.

Around the Museum


From San Jacinto you will see the mustang statue and the Museum up the hill to the right. Follow the left-hand set of steps up the hill. Continue on the sidewalk to the front entrance of the Museum on Trinity St.

Bus Parking

Bus parking is available across I-35, off of Comal St. south of Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.

Car Parking

Parking is available at the San Jacinto Garage located at 2500 San Jacinto Blvd., just north of the Museum. The first 30 minutes are free, after that there is a fee. We regret that Texas Memorial Museum cannot validate parking. Please note: Vehicle height restriction in San Jacinto Garage is 6'11". Should you need a higher clearance, Manor Garage on the southeast corner of Dedman Dr. and Littlefield is 8' on level 1 and 7' on remaining levels.

1-2 hours.....	\$6.00
2-3 hours.....	\$9.00
3-4 hours.....	\$12.00
4-8 hours.....	\$15.00

Garage rates are subject to change without notice. Special event parking may be charged a flat fee at entry regardless of the time actually parked.
